## 1. COVID-19

All participants must make sure to read the document Covid-19 available on the Covid-19 protocols page of [www.lrkartingclub.com/2020/05/lombardy-karting-club-covid-19-protocols/](http://www.lrkartingclub.com/2020/05/lombardy-karting-club-covid-19-protocols/)

1. a, Masks - It is mandatory to wear your mask on the pre grid. Those not wearing masks at the pre grid will be prevented from entering the pre grid area, no exceptions. The same rule applies under the Pavilion or approaching the snack shack.
1. b, All participants, volunteers and organizers must read and sign the waiver upon entry to the facility. Minor waivers for volunteers or participants must be signed by both parents or legal guardians before entry to the facility. Wristbands will be provided on entry to the facility. Drivers, mechanics, additional support, and LRKC organizers and volunteers will have wristbands put on them. This must stay on your wrist until the you leave the gate on Sunday July 26th after all the racing is finished. This will indicate colour coded areas of access and that you have signed the waiver and read the protocols.

2. EVENT This event is the third round of the 2020 Lombardy Karting Club Championship (LRKCC). This is considered a 'closed, restricted club event'. There will be 3 more rounds after this one for a total of 6 championship races.

## 3. TRACK LOCATION

LRKCC track is located at 6 Kellys Road, Lombardy, ON. K0G 1L0  
6-8 minutes south of Smiths Falls on highway 15 on the left heading south just after the golf course. The track is on the Lombardy Fairgrounds. Follow signs as you enter the main gate.

## 4. RACETRACK DESCRIPTION

The track has a length of 751 meters with 9 corners. All sessions will run clockwise full track.

## 5. HOSTING CLUB

The Lombardy Raceway Karting Club (LRKC) is the host of this event. This club event is sanctioned by ASQ . Drivers attending must be a member of another ASQ sanctioned club or hold an ASQ license or be a member of the LRKC. ### 8. ONSITE CAMPING

It is possible to sleep onsite from Friday night, July 24th and Saturday night July 25th. Camping space is by booking only, so you must register with us in advance. Camping spots are assigned on a "first come, first serve" basis. Campers must sign and follow camping rules. Fires are not allowed and no service is provided. ### 9. REGISTRATION

Registration is open online and must be done online or at the track no later than 5pm Saturday July 25th. The standard entry fee applies from the opening of the registration.

### 10. OFFICIAL GAS STATION

Gas used in all classes (except shifter classes) must be pump gas, grade 91 Supreme. Gas will be controlled with appropriated tools. The spec gas station for this event is the:

### 11. PARKING AND PADDOCK

You must get your paddock place from LRKC staff before setting up your paddock. If you use a spot other than yours, you will have to move. Vehicles must park in the designated parking. Team must send their paddock reservation to [info@lrkartingclub.com](mailto:info@lrkartingclub.com).  
Opening and closing of the main gate are indicated in the event schedule.  
You cannot drive your kart in the paddock. Use of a kart stand is mandatory at ALL TIMES, including during practice days.  
All motorized vehicles, bicycles, scooters, skateboards are forbidden at all time in the paddock and/or on the track. Exception: official vehicles from the organization.

### 12. GARBAGE DISPOSAL

General garbage: Drums/bins (many in the paddock). ***Do NOT put tires or oil containers*** in the drums/bins. All used oil and tires must be taken away by the user and not left on site.

### 13. ONSITE FOOD & BEVERAGES

The snack shack will be open for cold soft drinks, bottled water and snacks under Covid-19 protocols. Cash will be sanitized and touch free tap and go is available and encouraged. Picnic tables are located under the pavilion and only same house hold people may sit at the same table. Please do not move them from their physical distancing positions. You may bring your own food and drink but please follow the protocols in place.

7:30am - 8:45am Late transponder registration. Late pre tech check of karts for the season. Technical self-declaration at technical area

8:45am - 9:00am Drivers Meeting (Mandatory)

9:10am - 10:00am Warm-ups and tire and kart marking at scales.

10:00am - 15min break - 10:15am Race day commences

12:00pm -12:30pm Lunch

12:30pm - Racing continues with another 15 min break before the finals start. racing will finish no later than 5:00pm - deadline for track to close - Podiums shortly after

19:00pm Gate closed
